



**Lodging Hours of Operation** 0745 – 1630 Monday – Friday. Please call Security Police at 741-6210 or 989-354-6210 for any issue that cannot be resolved before lodging reopens.

**Emergencies:** 911, Use this number ONLY when life or property is in imminent danger.

**Lock-out and key:** Please contact your unit POC for lockouts when deployed as a unit or call 741-6316. After normal duty hours please call base Security at 741-6210.

All rooms have door locks which lock automatically when the door closes. Please remember to keep your key with you at all times. If you lock yourself out (especially when Lodging is closed ) you may have a lengthy wait to regain access. After hours please contact security at 741-6210

**Dormitory Policy:** The following rules are provided for your comfort and safety of all guests:

- Respect your neighbors: observe quiet hours– don't play TV / Radio too loudly.
- Inflammatory, Offensive or prejudicial material will not be displayed in any room.
- Weapons and ammunition are not permitted in any room. For storage of such items please call Security Police at 741-6210.
- Furniture will not be rearranged or taken outside of the rooms.
- Bicycles, auto parts, and etc., will not be kept in room.
- We have provided an iron and ironing board for all of our buildings in the day room. Please do not use the iron on carpet or furniture.

**Check out Time:** To allow for proper cleaning of all rooms checkout time is at 11:00 am unless coordinated with the lodging manager.

**Facility Problem:** For any problems with the rooms or building, please call the lodging office at 741-6316 or Civil Engineering help desk at 741-6265.

**Television Problem:** For any problems with the TV or Cable, please call the lodging office at 741-6316.

**Fire Safety:** For all fire emergencies call 911 from any base phone. Non emergencies call 741-6253.

- Personal BBQ Grills must be used 25 feet away from building.
- Candles and incense are prohibited in and room.
- Hot Plates and other cooking equipment are also prohibited.
- Fire evacuation Map, Please check your facility for the evacuation routes and rally points.

**Housekeeping:** Housekeepers are not permitted to enter any occupied guest room. If you have any problems or require service please let the Services staff know at 741-6316.

# General Information

**Internet :** The local commercial internet program is provided by base. Currently we have Wi-Fi hotspots in some dorms, laundry facility, Collins Center, and the River Club. Expanding plan is in place.

**Room Items:** We have provided; alarm clock, lamp, writing desk, wall lockers, refrigerator, and television for each room. Iron and Ironing Boards: are provided in each building in the dayroom.

**Valuables:** We have provided a wall locker for each room for you to secure your items. It is your responsibility to secure all of your valuables in your room.

**Telephone Instructions:** Not all phones have the ability to call or receive off-base calls.

- DSN call dial 94 for inside CONUS and 97 for outside CONUS.
- Absolutely no incoming collect calls will be accepted on any government phone.

**Laundry Facilities:** A self-service laundry facility is open 24 hours a day and is located in building 360. Your room key will open this facility. You will need provide your own detergent.

# FACT SHEET

## Alpena Combat Readiness Training Center

The Alpena Combat Readiness Training Center (CRTC) at Alpena, Michigan is one of four CRTCs located in the United States. The CRTC is funded by the Air National Guard and is directly under the command of the Adjutant General for the State of Michigan.



Alpena Combat Readiness Training Center (CRTC), formerly named Phelps Collins, began its recorded history in the early 1900's. Before that time, Indians and local residents picked blueberries in the flat area known as the "Seven Mile Plains". With the onset of air travel, area developers saw the potential for a landing strip and plans began for Michigan's first state owned airport. In 1931, Governor William M. Brucker accepted the site during the dedication ceremony.

Phelps Collins Air National Guard base (ANGB) is named in honor of the World War I pilot, Captain Phelps Collins. Captain Collins was an Alpena resident and war hero, who fought and died with the Lafayette Escadrille. Capt Collins, a pilot in the 103rd Aero Squadron, was on a combat patrol on March 12, 1918 to intercept enemy airplanes in the area of Paris when, for some unknown reason, his SPAD 7 plane crashed to earth in a high-speed dive from high altitude. He was the first member of the U.S. Air Service to lose his life.

The first military to use of Phelps Collins Airfield was the 1st Pursuit Group from Selfridge Airfield; and they housed 500 personnel at the Alpena County Fairgrounds. This marked the beginning of the site as a training base.

WWI and WWII highlighted the need for training Sites. The Army Air Corps was the primary user of the site until the late 1940's when the Air National Guard (ANG) took it over. Several improvements were made and the facility was identified as an ANG Permanent Field Training Site (PFTS).



In the early 60's, a tower and new hangers were built. During that period, the Air Defense Command Detachment from Wurtsmith AFB, Oscoda, Michigan, had personnel stationed in Alpena until 1972, at which time their unit was deactivated. The Grayling Air to Ground Range became part of the base property around the same time.

In 1989 another key aspect of the base's overall mission was initiated. Alpena CRTC began hosting, the ANG Medical Readiness Training Site (MRTS). This training program is designed to train ANG medical units from all over the United States. Throughout any given training year this program will train students in Expedition Medical Support (EMEDS), Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) courses, and other classes designed to enhance wartime medical readiness skills.

In 1991, the Phelps Collins Air National Guard Base was renamed Alpena Combat Readiness Training Center, to align the name with the base mission of "combat training".

In 1993 another mission was added to the CRTC. Due to closure of Wurtsmith AFB in Oscoda, the Alpena CRTC was tasked to provide its own radar approach control operation. The Alpena CRTC now provides excellent coverage for most of northeastern Lower Michigan and serves as a follow-on training site for Air Traffic Controller School. Another key addition to the base's assets was the addition of the Alpena Kadena Interim Training System (AKITS) system in 1999. Added in 2008 are three state-of-the-art Joint Threat Emitters (JTE). They provide the latest electronic warfare training to our military.

Throughout the years, the Alpena CRTC has continued to expand its overall capabilities. With the completion of the Fire Suppression Training complex in 1999 and the Military Operations in Urban Terrain training facilities in 2000, our training capabilities have kept up with the current real world requirements to train our airman for terrorism attacks and emergency response actions.

ANG personnel assigned to the base have provided aid for local area flooding and fires. Medical Readiness personnel deployed in response to Hurricane Katrina. CRTC personnel have also volunteered in support of operations: Desert Storm, Desert Shield, Iraqi Freedom, Joint Forge, Jump Start, Enduring Freedom, Northern Watch, Northern Eagle and Deep Freeze.

ANG units from all over the United States come to Alpena CRTC to train. In addition to Air National Guardsman, other users of the site include Air Force, Army, Navy, Coast Guard and Marines. Other regular users of the facility includes law enforcement agencies, canine training units, and youth cadets. Some unique users of the site have been Latvian, Dutch and Italian military. In 1989 some footage for the Die Hard 2 movie was filmed on the base.

The Alpena County Regional Airport is a county owned and operated facility on which the Alpena CRTC Air National Guard (ANG) is a tenant. The military area is isolated from the civilian area to provide minimal interference between the two. The flight line and maintenance facilities are subdued to provide a European NATO type operating environment. Sufficient winterized facilities are available to provide a year-round training capability.

The CRTC enjoys a relationship of friendship and respect with local townspeople. Each year, since early 1960's, the base has held events honoring the community. Air shows, community days, and dining outs have evolved into today's Annual Military Ball and has become an Alpena social highlight with over 300 local civilians in attendance.

During these times of ongoing Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC), the future of the Alpena CRTC looks promising. In 2011, the Alpena CRTC received certification as a Joint National Training Center (JNTC). The base's dedication to its mission is clear and continues to be a leader in providing the very best training site and facilities to prepare our military men and women who are charged with the responsibility of defending our land and protecting our liberties.

## **History of the City of Alpena**

Alpena Michigan is located on Lake Huron's northwestern coastline at the mouth of the Thunder Bay River. This scenic coastal town has retained much of its architectural tradition from the turn of the century, with many well-preserved houses and buildings - especially in the "old town" section just north of the Thunder Bay River.

Alpena was platted in 1856 by the name of Fremont. After some research by the 'founding fathers' it was discovered that Michigan already boasted a town named Fremont. At the recommendation of Henry R. Schoolcraft, a Michigan Statesman, Fremont was renamed Alpena. The name, Indian for partridge, was chosen because of the many fowl in the area. Alpena Michigan was eventually incorporated in 1871.

Besides tourism, Alpena's economy is supported by cement production, paper processing, and automotive/machine products manufacturing. Its downtown area is a great shopping location, situated conveniently next door to the marina.

This fact sheet was created to give you an overview of the CRTC and familiarize you with the Air National Guard in Alpena. The Alpena CRTC has a strong sense of duty, identity and commitment to those we serve. We are dedicated to ensure that our growth is beneficial to our community and nation.
