

Current Operations

Arizona National Guard continues with Phase 3 Respond efforts. The Arizona National Guard assists state and local partners in providing surge capacity and capability to the State of Arizona's COVID-19 emergency response. Currently 903 National Guard Soldiers and Airmen are assisting across all fifteen counties ISO COVID-19 efforts. ACS planning priority remains with the establishment of St. Luke (PHX), the Walgreens warehouse (FLG) followed by the Tucson Convention Center (TUS) and Fiesta Mall (PHX).

TASK FORCE MED continues to actively monitor the COVID-19 situation across the Navajo Nation coordinating response efforts to mitigate the risk to the tribal population. TF MED continues to coordinate medical response efforts within the Navajo Nation and is preparing a ground LOGPACK of medical suppliers to be ready to ship to the Navajo Nation if needed. TF MED ICW the Army continues to explore medical transportation options (FLA) to enable the transportation of low acuity patients from hospitals to ACS recovery sites.

JTF AZ ICW the Army and TF MED will explore training requirements should the National Guard be required to assist in transportation of medical patients.
